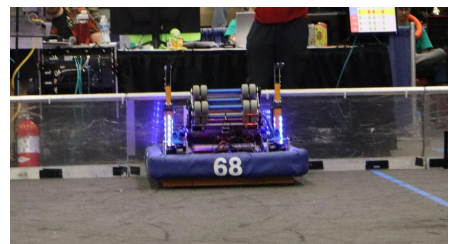
Competition Season Update

From April 4th to 6th, Truck Town Thunder, FIRST Robotics Competition(FRC) Team #68, went to the Michigan State Championship in Saginaw. After the two previous competitions, we succeeded to rank high enough to compete in the States Championship. We didn't have major issues, except for the bent side plates because of the matches. We placed 9th place out of 40 teams in the Qualification Matches. It was our highest record in our 26 year history. We competed as a captain of the 6th Alliance. Although we couldn't make it to the semi-finals,

We were qualified to compete in the World Championship, which was held from April 17th to 20th in Houston, Texas. In the Qualification Matches, we faced various problems, such as the connection with the radio between the drivers and the field, and the quality of batteries. Those small issues led our robot to be placed in 50th out of 75 teams. We'll acknowledge the flaws, and continue to improve our team for the next year's competitions.
