Well, we've been busy.. This last weekend, March 21st and 22nd, we competed at Kearsley High School in Flint. This was our first competition of our season.

While at Kearsley, we placed fourth out of forty-one teams overall. We joined the first alliance, going undefeated in the elimination bracket until we won the competition; coming home with gold medals and a new blue banner. While we were there, we also won the Excellence in Engineering award bolstering our chances of qualifying at the Michigan State Competition, and further to the World Championships.
