Build Season Week 8 Update!

What have been doing? The last seven weeks, our team has put in more than 121 hours working on designing, planning, manufacturing, programming, electrifying, and more on our robot that your donations have been able to help produce. Additionally, we have been strategizing on gameplay for our robot and team to be successful. While we have had a productive build season thus far, our team has identified numerous ways that we can improve, and are actively pursuing changes to advance.

During these seven weeks, we've faced many challenges. In order for our robot to be successful, we would like to score as many seven-inch foam balls as possible into the hub in the center of the playing field. Our current goal is to score 12 per second, and while we have not met that quota yet, we are hoping to surpass it before our first competition in three weeks. Another aspect we are currently deciding on is whether to install a climber on our robot for another ranking point, as it will use hopper space in exchange for the climb on the three-level steel ladder.
